AUBURN — Tim Duff pumped in 33 points and collected 17 rebounds to lead Christian Academy to a 74-55 Class S victory over Vinalhaven in the opening of the Western Maine basketball tourney in Edward Little High.

Duff, a 5-10 senior, scored heavily with a jump shot that was good up to 20 feet. He was the team's leading rebounder.

It wasn't until the third period that the Christians fed the Warriors to the Lions. Until then, Vinalhaven had made a bold stand, trailing only by 28-24 at halftime. This was a surprise to all in view of Christian's gaudy 16-2 pre-tourney record.

In the third period, Duff had four baskets and three free throws and Ted Chaffee, the tallest member of the starting team at 5-11, had five baskets. In the face of this offensive display, Vinalhaven, eighth seed on an 8-10 record, fell to a 19-point deficit going into the final eight minutes.

Ray Alley led Vinalhaven scoring with 13 points, most of them from fairly long range. Wayne Ames was the Warriors' top rebounder with 14, with Doug Carter, who had ten points, collecting a dozen caroms.

Christian had a rather poor 29 of 90 shots from scrimmage and added 16 of 25 free throws. Vinalhaven was 25 of 81 from the field and five of 12 from the foul line.
